Agostino Re Rebaudengo was born in Turin in 1959. He graduated in Economics and Business at the University of Turin. He completed his studies at the U.C.L.A. in Los Angeles and at the Harvard Business School in Boston, where he attended, among others, the OPM (Owner and President Management) course. He is a freelance journalist.

In 1995 he founded <u>Asja Ambiente Italia</u>, a company he is currently President and shareholder of. The company operates internationally, with offices in China and South America, and it is active in the production of biomethane and electricity from renewable energy sources. It also deals with energy efficiency, through the production and marketing of <u>TOTEM microcogenerators</u>.

From 2011 to 2017 he was President of

assoRinnovabili, the leading Italian association of renewable energy producers. On 28 April 2017 assoRinnovabili merged with Assoelettrica, the national association of Italian electricity companies, creating Elettricità Futura, and he first became Vice President and then President in July 2020. He has been a member of the Board of WindEurope (formerly EWEA - European Wind Energy Association). He has always been close to culture and arts: he was councillor to the Contemporary Art Museum Castello di Rivoli, President of the Turin Teatro Stabile from 1996 to 2007 and he is still engaged in non-profit organizations including the Sandretto Re Rebaudengo Foundation for contemporary art, for which he is cofounder and Vice President. He has been President of the Museum A come Ambiente since 2014.

Since 2019, he has been Professor at the Faculty of Engineering at the Biomedical Campus in Rome. He has been a Founding Member of the Social Promotion Academy of Financial Education since 2019.

In 2007 he was awarded the title of Commander of the Order of Merit of the Italian Republic, in 2018 of the title of Commander of the Order of Merit of the Colombian Republic and in 2021 of the title of Honorary Consul of the Colombian Republic. He is a member of several Italian and European clubs, as well as councillor to various associations. Since 2013, he has been a member of the General Council of Confindustria and since 2021 he has been Vice President of Confindustria Cisambiente with responsibility for energy and of Confindustria Energia with responsibility for hydrogen.
