

Salvatore Pinto, Chairman of Axpo Italia

Salvatore Pinto, born in 1957 and graduated in Electronic Engineering, has developed an international career within major industrial groups such as Telecom Italia, Pirelli and Olivetti, before joining the energy group EGL, later renamed Axpo Italia, in 2005 as Chairman, a role he is still holding to these days. At Axpo Italia he also held the dual role of Chairman and CEO from 2009 to 2016.

A long-time promoter of research in the field of renewable energies, in 2016 he founded and became Chairman of Green Energy Storage, a start-up dedicated to the development of innovative energy storage systems.

Since 2005, he has also served as Chairman of other companies within the Gruppo Axpo in Italy, including Calenia Energia S.p.A., Rizziconi Energia S.p.A., Axpo Gas Service Italia S.r.l., Axpo Energy Solutions Italia S.p.A. (formerly Energy Plus S.p.A.) and Axpo Servizi Produzione Italia S.p.A.

At Axpo Italia S.p.A., he currently holds specific delegations for Institutional & Regulatory Affairs and Country Corporate Communication.

Among his current positions, he serves as Member of the Advisory Board of the Camera di Commercio Svizzera in Italia, Chairman of Associazione Energia Libera, as well as Founder and Chairman of Skyres (Venture Capital Company) and Green Energy Storage Srl.

His previous appointments include Chairman of TAP (Trans Adriatic Pipeline Italia), Member of the Executive Board of Anasin, VP of Esoa, the association of European satellite operators, and Member of the Supervisory Board of Eutelsat and of the Consorzio Satellitare Galileo.
